Dogs and cats that go beyond **one year of age** without oral health care have a **dramatically increased risk of developing some form of dental disease.**

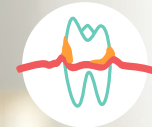

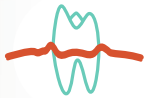
Teeth Truths



Bacteria forms on the teeth within **24 hours** of a professional cleaning and needs daily removal.



Plaque can calcify within **48-72 hours** and gingivitis can occur at **just 2 weeks**.



Gingivitis is the reversible stage while **periodontitis** requires surgery.



Not maintaining pets oral care can **possibly lead to infection** that can travel to internal organs.



Dental Disease is one of the most common, painful and overlooked diseases among our dog and cat populations.
